INTRAMURAL RULES

1. Intramurals are open to all students who complete and turn in their registration forms.
2. Intramurals will be held in the afternoon, from 4:00 - 5:30 p.m. Students will be notified of their team's schedule in advance to playing. Note that all teams might not play everyday.
3. Students must notify their parents in advance of their intentions to stay for intramurals. This is so they may arrange for transportation home.
4. **The student must be picked up no later than 5:30 p.m. If a problem arises with transportation the student may no longer be allowed to participate.**
5. Students must have notes from teacher/parent to enter late, or leave early. No exceptions will be allowed.
6. Intramurals are a **privilege** so we ask all participants to exhibit good sportsmanship and obey established school rules. You will not be allowed to play if you can not obey established rules.
